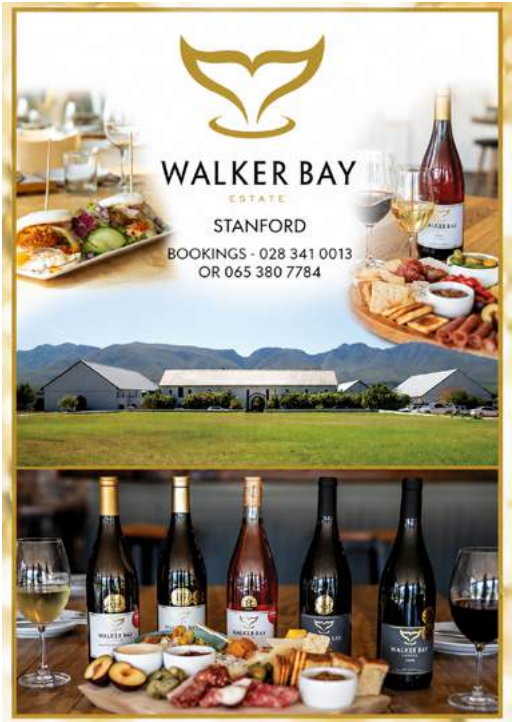

Life after Fire

The inspiration for the gold-award winning South African display at RHS Chelsea Flower Show 2026 and, of course, Stanford too, comes from the widespread wildfires which tore through several mountainous areas of the Cape in the 2025 / 2026 summer season including Stanford. Fire for fynbos is far from being a disaster; it is a crucial trigger that resets the fynbos ‘successional clock’ triggering healthy regrowth.

Leon Kluge’s exhibit offers a window into this remarkable fire-driven ecosystem. A large part of the display showcases the diversity of bulbs, orchids and other wildflowers which emerge after fire has swept through fynbos landscapes. Leon’s artform provides a showcase for the fynbos cutflower industry as well as the wild landscapes where it grows naturally.

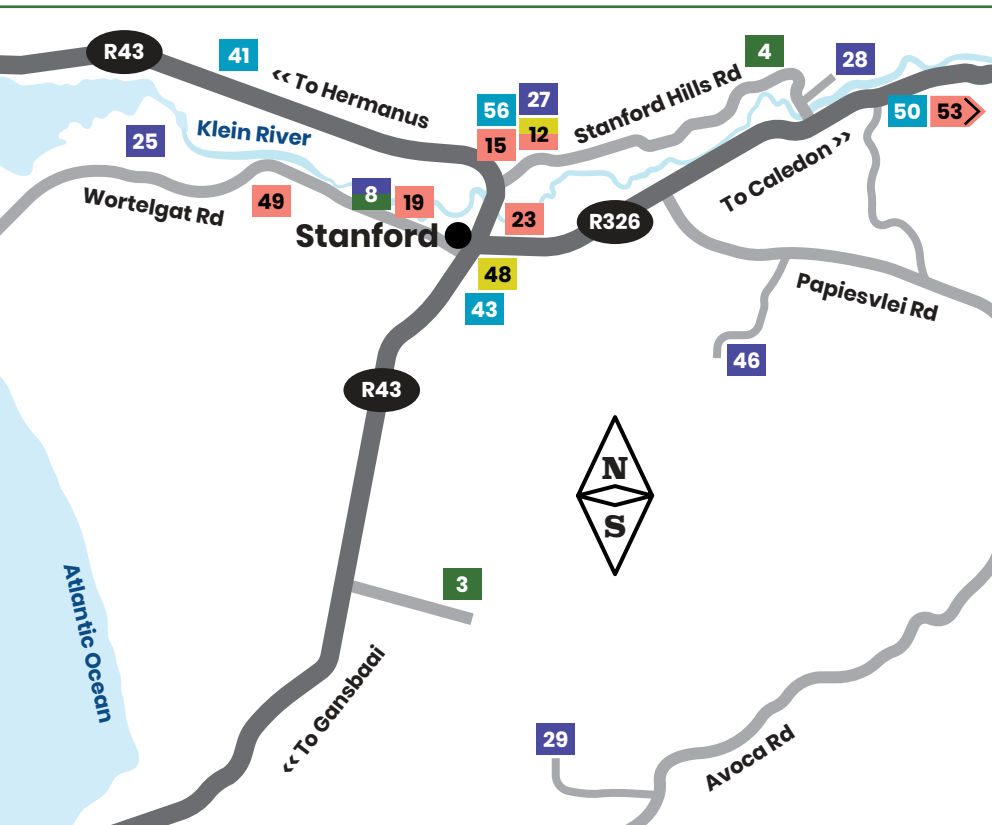
